

HiT - Light Instructions — The Art of the Switch!

We get it — hotel lighting systems can sometimes feel like a puzzle. Don't worry, we've made it easy. Here's a quick guide to help you out.

Each room has:

Main Switch

Located near the entrance, this switch controls the main power in your room — including all lights, the A/C, and power outlets. Turning it off will cut power to most devices.

Room Light Panel



You'll find a central lighting control panel in the room. Use it to turn ceiling lights, desk lights, and other room lighting on or off with just a tap.

Bathroom Light Panel

Inside the bathroom, a dedicated panel allows you to control the mirror lighting and the wall-mounted bulb. Easy and intuitive.

Bedside Reading Lamps

These are manually controlled with a small switch located directly on each lamp — perfect for nighttime reading without lighting up the whole room.

Designer Lamps

If a light isn't responding to the panels, you might be in luck — you've discovered one of our unique designer lamps! These have their own manual switch, typically found on the base or cord.
